Highlights

TANZANIA

Tarangire National Park: In the dry season (August-October) this park has one of the highest concentrations of wildlife of any East African park, particularly abundant are: zebras. Wildebeests, hartebeests, elephants, kudus, gazelles, giraffes, impalas, leopards and to a lesser extent rhino. The park is also famous for its baobab trees.

Ngorongoro: The Ngorongoro Conservation area covers 8300 sq km. The 20 km wide crater has abundant water attracts varied and abundant wildlife., particularly common are Elephants, gazelle, reedbucks, gazelle and zebras. The crater is particularly good for viewing lion and rhino. The local Maasii also have grazing rights here and can be seen grazing their cattle.

Serengeti: Perhaps Africa's best known park. The vast tree-less grasslands make game viewing particularly easy. Lion are particularly plentiful here. Here will perhaps be the best chance of seeing a "kill".

Lake Manyara: Famous for its approx. 3 million flamingos, the area is also renown for its unique tree climbing lions. Hippos are also common.

Zanzibar: The old stone town a romantic blend of Arabian, Indian African and European architecture. The archipelago has some of Africa's finest beaches; our resort is located on one of them.

UGANDA

Kabale: A particularly beautiful area renown for its terraced mountains, forests, lakes and volcanoes.

Lake Bunyoni: One of the worlds deepest lakes and one of its most scenic. Dotted with many islands the lake is famous for its crayfish and birdlife.

Bwindi Inpenetrable

National Park: Aptly named the only access is by foot, gorilla tracking is truly a memorable experience. To protect the gorillas only twenty four visitors are allowed each day.

Queen Elizabeth Park:

During Idi Amin's misrule ivory poaching was rampant in this area, only now is the elephant population recovering, but the scenery and the 600 species of birds make the visit worth while

Kibale Forest Reserve: This tropical forest is home to the worlds largest chimp population; approx. 600. Our lodge overlooks the stunning Crater Lake and the Mountains of the Moon.
